

## 83/92 Jean Yakovi Degli (on behalf of Caporal N. Bikagni) / Togo

Communication on unlawful detention.

1. “The African Commission on Human and Peoples’ Rights established under [Article 30](#) of the African Charter on Human and Peoples’ Rights;
2. Recalling the provisions of [Article 57](#) of the Charter and those of [Rules 110](#) and [115](#) of the Rules of Procedure which stipulate that prior to any substantive consideration, all communications must be brought to the knowledge of the State concerned;
3. Notes that the said communication was brought to the attention of the State of the Togo on 11 November 1992;
4. Confirms the [Rule 109](#) interim measures taken during the 14<sup>th</sup> session aimed at ensuring the security of the victim and to avoid irreparable prejudice to be inflicted on the victim of the alleged violations” ([Article 57](#) of the Charter; [Articles 110](#) and [115](#) of the Rules of Procedure).
