Final Decision

- **1.** The African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights, established under <u>Article 30</u> of the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights;
- 2. Meeting at its Fifteenth Ordinary session held in Banjul, The Gambia, from 18 to 27 April 1994;
- **3.** Recalling the provisions of <u>Article 57</u> of the Charter and those of <u>Rules 110</u> and <u>115 of the Rules of Procedure</u> which stipulate that prior to any substantive consideration, all communications must be brought to the knowledge of the State concerned;
- **4.** Notes that the said communication was brought to the attention of the State of the Republic of Guinea on 13/11/92, 12/4/93 and 12/3/94;
- **5.** Requests the Guinean Government to submit additional information relating to the issue within 2 months of the receipt of a new notification, failing which this matter shall be considered during the Sixteenth Session; (Article 57 of the Charter; Articles 110 and 115 of the Rules of Procedure).
