Communication on detention without trial.

Final Decision

1. The African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights, established under [Article 30](#) of the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights;
2. Meeting at its Fifteenth Ordinary session held in Banjul, The Gambia, from 18 to 27 April 1994;
3. Recalling the provisions of [Article 57](#) of the Charter and those of [Rules 110](#) and [115 of the Rules of Procedure](#) which stipulate that prior to any substantive consideration, all communications must be brought to the knowledge of the State concerned;
4. Notes that the said communication was brought to the attention of the State of the Republic of Guinea on 13/11/92, 12/4/93 and 12/3/94;
5. Requests the Guinean Government to submit additional information relating to the issue within 2 months of the receipt of a new notification, failing which this matter shall be considered during the Sixteenth Session; ([Article 57](#) of the Charter; [Articles 110](#) and [115 of the Rules of Procedure](#)).
